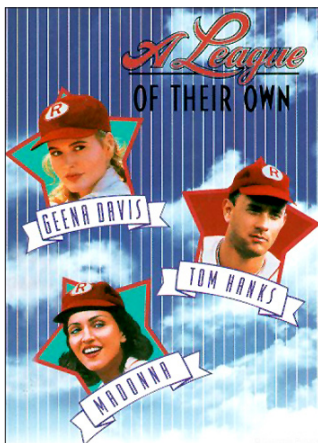
SOME LIKE IT HOT
