The pandemic looks different for everyone, so we're offering three different options for you and your students to enjoy Roberson on your terms!




Synchronous

Can't come to see us? We'll bring Roberson to you! Join us for one, two, or three of our special virtual programs below where your students will interact in real-time with a Museum educator as you are guided through an activity and video tour of our exhibits. *Bonus: Pre and post activities for your students are included so the learning continues even when we log off.*

Length: 30–45 minutes
Capacity: Max of 25 students

VIRTUAL TRIPS

Our virtual programs are available in synchronous and asynchronous formats to allow students to interact in real-time with a Museum educator or explore on their own using the provided museum guides. Programs can be adapted to meet the needs of other grade levels. Multiple sessions can be scheduled to accommodate a larger number of students.



Asynchronous

Not sure if you can gather all of your students at once? Don't worry, there is still an option for you! All three of our synchronous programs are also available in an asynchronous format. We provide you with a video tour of the exhibit (not guided) and an activity guide so you can teach the program on your own time. Choose 1, 2, or all 3!

Habitat Adapt

(Grades 2–5)

Join us as we take a walk through nature in Roberson's semi-permanent NatureTrek exhibit. Students will observe the biodiversity of five distinct habitats native to upstate New York. Within each habitat, students will learn to identify the adaptations of birds and mammals, and how they help the animal to survive.

Haudenosaunee Culture

(Grades 3–7)

*Available beginning April 30th

Explore the history and culture of the Haudenosaunee—their beliefs and philosophies, relationship with the land, and association with Europeans migrating to North America. Students will help tell the story of this Nation of native peoples as they observe artifacts, written materials, and diagrams from Roberson's Haudenosaunee exhibit.


Night Sky Tour

(All grade levels)

Using the same software found in our digital planetarium, we can take you on a tour of the night sky from your very own computer screen! Students will engage in the Earth and Space Science disciplines while discovering the wonders of our solar system and beyond. Is there something special you want to see? Let us know and we can incorporate it into your tour!

IN-PERSON TRIPS

Experience some of Roberson Museum's most popular exhibitions and features throughout this museum sampler program. **Students will participate in all three 45 minute programs listed below.** This program has been developed as a low touch, socially distanced option and can be adapted for all grade levels.



Historic Mansion Tour

Grades K–12

Step back into the Gilded Age and walk through several floors of this historic mansion built by Alonzo and Margaret Roberson. This house had all of the modern conveniences of the time: elevator, gas and electric lighting, and central heat. Become immersed in our rich local history and find out what life was like for the Robersons.



NatureTrek

Grades K–12

This program invites you to walk through five distinct habitats native to the upstate New York region. On your journey, you'll meet dozens of mammals and birds that occupy these ecological niches. Having made their acquaintance, students will dive into the Life Sciences as they investigate the relationships between them and how they are equipped to survive.



Planetarium Exploration

Grades K–12

Explore the night sky in the area's only full-dome digital planetarium. Become immersed in the Earth and Space Science disciplines while sitting back and gazing up at the stars. Students will enjoy a short film followed by a guided tour of the night sky. There are many options that can allow you to choose what is best suited for your needs.
